The Greater Baltimore Climate Summit is hosted by a committee of professionals from Morgan State University, Baltimore Green Space, the HBCU Environmental Justice Technical Collaborative, and more local organizations.

The summit is an innovative gathering—inspired by forward-thinking programming of California's Strategic Growth Council—tailored to the unique needs of Baltimore City and its surrounding counties. GBCS aims to foster collaboration dedicated to enhancing the region's environmental infrastructure and programming.

### 2024-2025 Impact

The success of the inaugural summit is measured by impactful efforts to execute the summit **in less than 90 days** in collaboration with 22 partners including Morgan State University, Green & Healthy Homes Initiatives, Canopy by Hilton, John Hopkins Urban Health Institute, Environmental Defense Fund, University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science, National Aquarium, HBCU Environmental Justice Tech Collaborative, Interfaith Power & Light DMV and more.

At the 2024 summit, keynote speaker **Dr. Leslie Gillespie-Marthaler** (US EPA Region 3 Director) emphasized collective action, while plenary speakers like **Ava Richardson** (Baltimore Office of Sustainability Director) and **Dr. Sacoby Wilson** (UMD CEEJH Director) discussed environmental justice, air quality, and the intersection of health and climate. The summit also featured insightful speakers such as **Maryland Senator Ben Brooks and Ruth Ann Norton**, who shared valuable perspectives on climate finance, public administration, and transforming Baltimore into a sustainable region.

Additionally, the initiative has surveyed 846 regional stakeholders on priority climate issues and engaged 609 event participants since last November. Well on its way to expanding its impact to serve the state Maryland and the mid-Atlantic in 2026, the Greater Baltimore Climate Initiative is expanding to encompass four projects including the summit, Building Greater Baltimore Momentum Web Series, Past Performance Project and Community-Environmental Scorecard.





















